PART I: APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 1. Recommended Level of Language Proficiency
- Mandarin-taught courses:
- Students are advised to achieve a minimum of TOCFL Superior or HSK Level 4 if they want to take Mandarin-taught academic courses. Some colleges/departments (e.g. College of Informatics and College of Science) may require a higher level of Mandarin proficiency.
- English-taught courses:
- Students who wish to take academic classes taught in English are advised to demonstrate English proficiency at least equivalent to TOEFL iBT 80 / IELTS 6.0 / TOEIC 700 / CEFR B2.
- 2. Period of Study
- One semester (Fall or Spring) or one academic year.
- 3. Application Deadline (Late submissions will not be accepted)

Fall semester (2026/09-2026/12): April 20, 2026

Spring semester (2027/02-2027/06): October 26, 2026

4. Class Begins/Ends

2026 Fall Semester: September 2026 to December 2026

2027 Spring Semester: February 2027 to June 2027

PART II: POST-ADMISSION & PRE-ARRIVAL

1. Arrival Time:

• Students are recommended to arrive Taiwan 7-10 days before the course starts. There will be an orientation held by NCCU Office of International Cooperation one week before the semester start.

2. Estimated Expenses

For a one-semester exchange student

- a. Tuition (paid to home institution)
- b. Medical insurance (paid to your insurance company)
- c. Taiwanese visitor visa
- d. On-campus health check-up: NT\$ 600 (About EUR19)
- e. NCCU safety insurance: NT\$126
- f. On-campus dormitory: NT\$23,000 + NT\$1,000 deposit
- g. Food: NT\$15,000 per month
- h. Public Transport: NT\$3,000 per month
- i. Textbooks: NT\$5,000-NT\$8,000 per semester

3. Student Housing

- Please fill in your preference in application form. Due to limited space in dorms and I-House, NCCU will conduct first-come-first-serve method to arrange housing for applicants.
- Besides the dorm fee, student will also need to pay NT\$1,000 dorm deposit separately, which will be returned after checking out if the room is clean and undamaged.

• On-campus Dormitory

- a. 4-person room for undergraduate; around NT\$11,000 per semester
- b. 2-person room for master's students; around NT\$23,000 per semester
- Off-campus International House (I-House)

a. limited single suites and double suites are available.





- b. Double Suites: NT\$38,250 per semester
- c. Single Suite: NT\$58,500 per semester.
- d. Additional Fees: refundable deposit of one-month rent, phone call and electricity fees (if exceeds the free basic quota).
- Off-campus House Rental: Fees range from NT\$8,000-20,000 per month.

4. Health Insurance

• NCCU Student Safety Insurance (group insurance):

Applies to all NCCU students (local students / international degree & exchange students).

NT\$183 per semester.

- For one-semester exchange: Overseas Medical Insurance
 Students who only exchange for 1 semester, please purchase your own
 medical insurance in your home country to cover your medical expenses
 during your entire stay in Taiwan
- For one-year exchange: Overseas Medical Insurance + NHI (National Health Insurance): Students are required to join NHI after 6 months of continuous residence in Taiwan. Before joining NHI, you will need to have your own overseas medical insurance to cover your medical costs during the first 6 months.

5. Health Check-up

• For one-semester exchange:

Students are required to participate on-campus health checkup (date to be advised) Fee: NT\$ 600

• For one-year exchange:

Students have to provide health check-up report to the immigration bureau for ARC application.





6. Exchange Students VISA & ARC

- Two types of Visas for international students:
 - Visitor Visa: short-term visa; for stay less than 180 days
 - Resident Visa: long-term visa; for stay longer than 180 days
- For one-semester exchange:

60- or 90-day Visitor Visa → Visitor Visa Extension (twice as the maximum extension times)

- For one-year exchange:
 - ➤ If enter in Taiwan with Visitor Visa → apply for Resident Visa → apply for ARC → join National Health Insurance after 6 months
 - ➤ If enter in Taiwan with Resident Visa → apply for ARC → join National Health Insurance after 6 months

Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) (one-year exchange only)

- Students who enter Taiwan with a Resident Visa will need to apply for the ARC at the Immigration Agency within 15 days after landing.
- Your ARC will have multiple entries before the expiration date.
- Application fee: NT\$ 1,000

7. Mandarin Course

 OIC offers 3-credits Part-time Mandarin course free of charge to exchange students. Whether the credits could be transferred will be decided by the student's home university.

8. Recommended Number of Credit per semester
