Accommodation	A limited number of places available at dormitories for exchange students. Places are in double rooms with a shared bathroom and kitchen. Students apply for accommodation in the on-line application form at https://irk.uw.edu.pl/en-gb/home/ (one form for both studies and accommodation). The places are assigned on a "first come first served" basis therefore it is important to apply as early as possible. Students who do not receive a place in a dormitory are offered assistance in finding a room or apartment to rent.

Visa	Short-term students (one or two semesters) are usually required to obtain the National visa (visa type D). For more information, please check our Welcome Point website and contact the Embassy/Consulate General of Poland in the country you are currently residing.
Health Insurance	Each incoming student is required to have health insurance valid for the entire duration of their stay in Poland and at the University of Warsaw. Please check the specific requirements with the relevant Embassy or Consulate General of Poland, as valid health insurance is required to obtain a visa. Upon arrival at the University of Warsaw, students will be asked to present proof of their health insurance. It is strongly recommended that the insurance confirmation be issued in English or Polish, in case medical assistance is needed.
Additional Information	Exchange students are entitled to one class of Polish language, to one class of foreign language class and one sports class free of charge in addition to courses offered by their receiving unit (within the limit of 30 ECTS/semester).
